We have been bandaging our wounds together since the first day of the earthquake.

The earthquake was the strongest to strike Turkiye since 1939 and the most devastating natural disaster in our lifetime. Eleven major cities were severely affected: Kahramanmaras, Hatay, Kilis, Diyarbakir, Adana, Osmaniye, Gaziantep, Sanliurfa, Adiyaman, Elazig and Malatya.
