

## PERTEVNIYAL VALIDE SULTAN



Italian designed mosque, built in 1871 for the mother of Sultan Abdülaziz and reflecting various styles. The Pertevniyal Valide Sultan Mosque is a grand Ottoman imperial mosque in

Istanbul. The building is an example of Turkish Rococo with dollops of classical Ottoman, Moorish, Gothic, Renaissance, and Empire styles. The design also seems to draw influences from Indian, North African, and Andalusian architecture. It can be seen as a sign of the emerging power of Ottoman women, as the mosque is named after Pertevniyal Valide Sultan, a member of the royal family. The interior is elaborately decorated with much use made of blue colouring. There are many classical Ottoman details on the walls including blind niches, muqarnas, arch motifs, arabesques, and Chinese-inspired floral arrangements.
