This month, we welcomed delegations from the Shanghai University of Political Science and Law from China! We believe that our collaboration will result in projects that benefit both of our universities!




### Delegation Visit from Pakistan!

## ATATÜRK CITY FOREST

## Wide forested slope with walking paths and lake, preferred for hiking and picnics

Atatürk City Forest (formerly known as Haciosman Grove) is a park and forest area located in the Sariyer district of Istanbul. It has three ponds and hiking trails and covers an area more than 1,000 acres. Atatürk City Forest is divided into two by a deep valley between Haciosman and Derbent. There are two natural ponds (Big Pond, Small Pond) arranged consecutively in this valley. There are more than ten species of trees in the forest and on the roadside between the two ponds, Istanbul dandelion, comfrey, euphorbia and Turkish lily are endemic plants in the grove. It is possible to reach the grove from the Haciosman and Darüşşafaka metro stations located in the north and south.
