FOSTERING ACADEMIC EXCHANGE: NEW INTER-INSTITUTIONAL AGREEMENTS

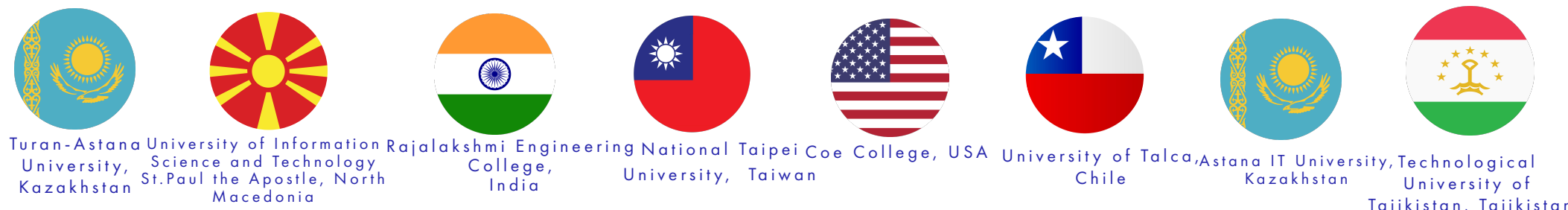

The International Summer School offers a variety of tracks of Business courses as well as language and cultural studies.

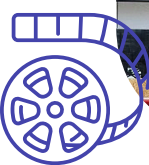
ALUMNI RELATIONS Alumni Office Türkiye Alumni Portal

Our alumni, who last took action to solve the water scarcity problem in Nigeria, shared the matter as follows: "Thanks to the multicultural environment of Altınbaş University, I met my Nigerian friend Dr. Aliyu Kyari GUBIO. My friend told me about the water needs in Nigeria. Thanks to our collaboration, we started collecting donations from our friends in Nigeria, Türkiye, and Egypt and began opening water wells. So far, we have opened a total of 32 water wells. As a doctor, I want to contribute to humanity in every way possible."



C-TALKS SERIES

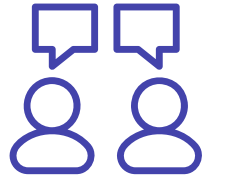
